This summit is a continuation of the series of Black/Brown Dialogues which brought together Latinos, African Americans, and members of other marginalized groups to examine issues of common concern to their communities and identify ways by which to move forward in pursuit of a more equitable and inclusive social order in Michigan. Participants identified and rank-ordered ten issues of major concern to their communities; developed steps to address the concerns. At the top of the concerns is education. It is always education. The objective of this summit is to deepen our understanding of multicultural education and identify opportunities to promote multicultural education.
